



Brexit overview

- Final deadline: 31st December 2020.
- ➤ Changes coming into force at 00:00:01 CET time on 1st January 2021.
- ➢ Be prepared for No-Deal Brexit including payment of duties before goods release in EU.
- Duties needs to be prepaid in case of No-Deal.
- Shorter transit times mean less time for import and export documentation. Pre-notify Customs Support before picking up goods.
- Make sure all documentation contains required data (Incoterms / HS Codes / IOR/EOR with EORI and VAT, Value and origin of goods).



Impact after January 1st 2021

- Europe: from 1st January 2021 import and export documents required (No transition period).
- Your credit limits with us are maintained. Be prepared to pay more frequently.
- Expect huge delays in processing time of documents.
